features oak hardwood floors laid in an intricate basket weave pattern. The gourmet kitchen includes alder wood cabinets, granite countertops, two pantries, and a planning center that helps to keep everything organized. The kitchen opens to a large dining room and spacious family room with lots of windows for natural lighting. If entertaining, or homeowners just want to enjoy the outdoors, the dining room opens to a covered patio with retractable screens. A large second master bedroom enjoys views of Founder's Square, and is complete with a private veranda.
